The General Secretariat for Gender Equality of the Ministry of Interior and Administrative Reconstruction implements the Flagship Project "Service organization for the integration, monitoring and evaluation of Gender Equality Policies in all aspects of Public Sector's Actions (Observatory)". The aim of this Project is to support Public Administration and Local Governments to design, implement and evaluate policies concerning gender equality, through detailed data on equality issues (statistics and surveys) deriving from the development and function of relevant tools.

Under this frame, actions of publicity for the project are being implemented and particularly 8 technical meetings/ workshops with the participation of officials, 2 conferences and production of printed and electronic informative materials.

The **Sixth Technical Meeting / Workshop** was held on Thursday, July 16th, 2015, to inform the participants for the purpose and the implementation progress of the Project.

In this meeting participated government officials of the **General Secretariat for Gender Equality** of the Ministry of Interior and Administrative Reconstruction, the Coordination, Managing and Implementation Authority for co-funded actions of the **Ministry of Interior and Administrative Reconstruction - EYSYDE** of the **Ministry of Interior and Administrative Reconstruction**, as well as officials of the **GSEE**, **IME-GSEBEE** and the **Ministry of Education and Religious Affairs**.

An official of the **EYSYDE of the Ministry of Interior and Administrative Reconstruction** carried out a thorough presentation of the Project, while the individual subcontractors carried out a special presentation of the subprojects.
